

The Convalescent Home of Winnipeg's Visitation Protocols (Effective May 11, 2022)

- All visitors will gain access to our Home via our front doors (facing Hugo Street North) and be greeted by a Recreation staff member.
- You will be screened as per present steps (temperature check and standard health status questions). Proof of vaccination is NOT required.
- Hand sanitization remains a critical infection control practice – both upon arrival and departure.
- Once successfully screened, you will be provided with a medical grade facemask to wear throughout your visit, as well as offered protective eyewear (optional to use – the eyewear is multi-use; please retain and bring with you for future visits – limit of one pair per person); and be asked to sign our Guestbook. (When leaving our Home, please also record your departure time in the same Guestbook.)
- Thereafter, you will be free to access an elevator and proceed to your loved one's floor/room for your visit.
- **Per Resident, only two visitors at a time will be accommodated.** Please coordinate visit days/times amongst family/friends so that you do not exceed the allowable limit.
- Children are welcome to visit at our Home. 😊 Little ones of age 5 and up will be required to wear a mask when at our Home. On floor visitation remains restricted to 2 visitors per Resident at any one time (including if one of the two visitors is a child).
- You may visit with your loved one in their room or anywhere in our Home that space is available.
- Weather permitting, should an outdoor visit be able to be accommodated, visitor numbers may be stretched up to 4 visitors (plus Resident) – presuming masks are worn, and you are able to social distance.
- Food/beverages/treats/gifts, etc. may be delivered/given to your loved one as part of your visit; however, we remind visitors to always wear their facemask when in our Home (and not to remove your own mask to eat/drink).
- No pet visits are allowed.
- Should an outbreak be declared at our Home, visits will NOT be permitted. Notice will be provided to families/friends as quickly as possible should an outbreak situation arise.
